







## Percentages of PFCC CHILDREN by PROGRAM QUALITY and Race & Ethnicity





## FY 17% of Students DEMONSTRATING READINESS for Kindergarten by Race & Ethnicity




### Third Grade Reading

## FY 17% of Students Proficient & Above on Third Grade Reading BY RACE & ETHNICITY






Gaps between **CHILDREN IN POVERTY** and their higher income peers emerge much earlier than state and federal policy recognizes and persist long into adulthood.




